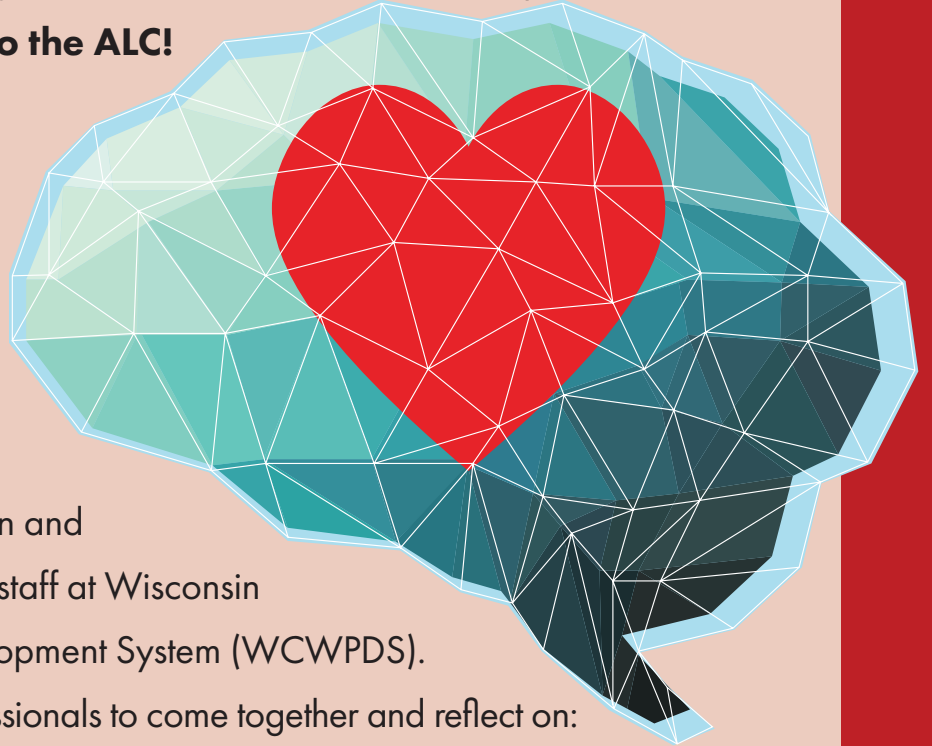


WCWPDS's Child Welfare Applied Learning Communities (ALCs)
